# **CoachBoatRegulations**

## **1 GENERAL**

- 1.1 An alleged breach of any of these regulations may be reported to the International Jury for a hearing. If the jury decides the breach was significant, it may instruct the organizing authority to withdraw accreditation and access rights to the Subic Bay Yacht Club and the racing areas from the offending party without the option of replacement during the regatta.
- 1.2 Coaches and other support personnel are warned that a boat may be disqualified under racing rule 41, Outside Help.
- 1.3 The organizing authority reserves the right to change these regulations at any time. Changes will be posted on the official notice board at the venue and circulated to the team leaders.
- 1.4 The organizing authority may, at its discretion, refuse coach boats not deemed to be suitable. Generally, open boats less than 7.5 metres in length having minimum or no superstructure (cabin, coach house, bridge, etc.) would be considered suitable.
- 1.5 Coach boats shall not display any form of advertising, publicity or propaganda, commercial or otherwise.
- 1.6 Coach boats and their drivers shall be registered before 1700 on 26 November. An insurance certificate for the boat shall be presented at registration. The boat shall be insured with adequate third-party liability insurance. Coaches that do not have a boat but wish to go afloat shall register at the same time.
- 1.7 Each coach boat shall either fly a flag of minimum size 40 cm x 50 cm displaying its national letters in black on a white background or display its national flag of a similar size. In addition, the organizing authority may provide numbers that shall be displayed on the bow.
- 1.8 The organizing authority may require any coach boat to carry one or more coaches or other support personnel from other competing nations and to offer assistance and support to athletes of those nations whose coaches or support personnel are on board.

## **2 SUBIC BAY YACHT CLUB AND WATER VENTURES BOATING CENTRE**

- 2.1 Only registered coach boats may use the facilities at the Yacht Club and the Sailing Centre.
- 2.2 Coach boats are required to dock at the numbered spaces assigned to their national authority.

## **3 SECURITY**

- 3.1 Only registered coach boats are allowed in the sailing areas.

#### **4 COMPETITION**

- 4.1 The registered driver of a coach boat will be responsible for the control of the boat at all times and will be held responsible for any inappropriate behaviour, dangerous actions or improper practices affecting the fairness of competition.
- 4.2 Coach boats may not put any device, piece of equipment, buoy, marker or similar item in the water.
- 4.3 Coach boats shall comply with directions given by the race committee and marine police, including requests to assist in rescue operations.
- 4.4 At the first warning signal of the day, coach boats shall retire to the Coach Boat Zone until all racing has been completed, postponed or abandoned for that racing area, unless instructed otherwise by the race committee.
- 4.5 The Coach Boat Zone is defined by a line 75 metres behind the Start Line and 75 metres behind the Finish Line
- 4.5 Between racing sessions or when all racing for that racing area has been postponed or abandoned, coach boats may enter the racing area in order to service their athletes' needs.  
If further racing is to take place, coach boats shall retire to the Coach Boat Zone when the orange flag is displayed to indicate racing will soon begin.
- 4.6 Coach boats shall not carry on board any electronic devices except
- a marine VHF radio, which may be used only for rescue and other emergency operations;
  - any device for time keeping only;
  - a hand-held device for measuring wind speed and compass bearing;
  - any electronic equipment strictly related to the safe operation of the boat and engine;
  - photo cameras;
  - video cameras;
  - a tape or digital voice recorder;
  - electronically stabilized binoculars.
- 4.7 While on the water, a coach boat shall not carry equipment capable of making radio transmissions or receiving radio communications, except for equipment allowed in regulation 4.6.
